Hello CPCA Member, A Message About the NEW Canada CoatingsHUB

The Canada CoatingsHUB is now LIVE! ALL CPCA Members have received activation notices from the website. **In the coming weeks and months CPCA will be transitioning all communications over to the HUB.** We will continue to send out our monthly publications, however, access to the content within is user login driven, which requires **ALL members to activate their user accounts on the NEW CPCA website and member portal the Canada CoatingsHUB.**

Tools and Terminology you can Expect While Navigating the HUB

CPCA Compliance Calendar vs. Events Calendar

The "Event Calendar" displays the main national and international events organized for the CASE industry. This calendar is publicly accessible. The "Compliance

Calendar” is accessible to members only. This calendar displays all survey and consultation end dates for national regulatory proposals as well as all final dates for the coming into force of specific regulatory actions affecting or possibly affecting CPCA members.

CPCA Notification of New Resource Postings on the HUB

Status for each relevant posting to the member resources on the Hub is one of the following:

1) Member Information Only

CPCA information-only posts will be posted as a new resource but members will **‘not’** be notified via email alerts, but members can see when logged into their account new posts available via their dashboard. These include general reference documents, committee minutes, CPCA submissions, position papers, CPCA bulletins, etc. Members need to visit the site from time to time to directly access it via a simple search or viewing individual resource postings. Also, at the end of each month, some of these informational resources along with the others will be captured in the **Regulatory RADAR** posted on the Hub to ensure nothing relevant to ongoing issue management by you or your team is missed.

2) Member Action Required

There are important compliance actions requiring members to act and these include timing of important government consultations, member surveys requiring a response, relevant deadlines such as Canada Gazette notices, enforcement dates for any type of regulations, etc. a “direct notification” called “Member Alert” will be sent to those members who have specifically asked to be notified on any of the 12 issues they selected to follow within the ‘edit my account’ section of the HUB. These may also include notifications of CPCA annual conferences, training sessions, webinars, or networking events, inviting members to register by a specific date.

3) Compliance Deadline: “CPCA Compliance Calendar” is accessible to members only on the Hub. This calendar displays all survey and consultation end dates for national regulatory proposals as well as all final dates for the coming into force of specific regulatory actions affecting or possibly affecting CPCA members. In cases where there is a compliance deadline associated with a resource, a notification is sent to ALL members because there is a need for the member companies to address information provided within these resource postings. Two reminder alerts, one called “14-day Alert” and then a final “7-day Alert” are sent to members as an email reminder. There will be no further email notification alerts on the matter after the deadline has passed.

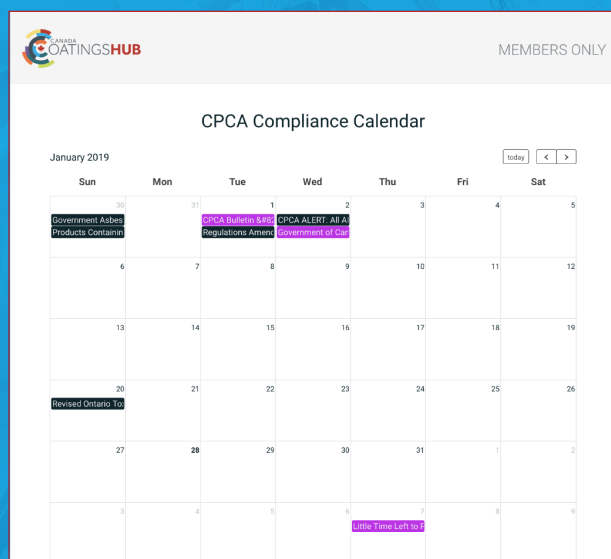

Chemicals Management in Canada & Post-2020

CPCA Answers Survey on CMP Program Evaluation

These results will inform planning for a **future CMP program**.

2017-2018 IRAP Results Identify Chemicals and Polymers Lists for Post-2020 Risk Assessment

The following substances will be targeted: DSL substances not yet assessed since the last 5 years under the CMP; Previously assessed substances not found to meet the criteria; Substances nominated by CMP program staff; and, substances potentially requiring review pursuant to s.75.

Industry Concerned With Health Canada Launch of Healthy Home Social Marketing Campaign

Canada.ca/healthy-home, considered a **key CMP public outreach initiative** led by HC, is now live.

Chemicals Management Phase 3 & Chemicals Management Phase 2

CPCA Confirmed Current CMP-3 TiO₂ DSAR Status:

Not Expected Before Late 2020

Despite the actual context of the recent EU classification decision on TiO₂, Health Canada's PCWG sector lead confirmed to CPCA that the risk assessment team is still at an information gathering stage with TiO₂.

Stakeholders Consulted on Informed Substitution and Alternatives Assessment

ECCC and HC are seeking stakeholder feedback on opportunities to renew and modernize the CMP regarding informed substitutions and alternatives assessment until March 18.

Canada Gazette Draft Screening Assessment (DSAR) for Pigment and Dyes 60-day Consultation Period ends March 3, 2019

Six substances proposed to be of no concerns.

Upcoming CMP-3 DSARs in Spring 2019

Several DSARs are expected according to the 2-year rolling plan.

Biocide Preservatives

CPCA Provides Key Messaging to PMRA on Proposed Improved Pesticide Re-evaluation Program and Process & Is Creating CPCA Paint Biocides Council

PMRA consultation docs are available for download. CPCA continues to work on building a Canada Paint Biocide Council that will be composed of 10-12 representatives of CPCA registrants and manufacturer members, ACA, US EPA and PMRA officials.

International Government Initiatives

CPCA/ACA Push for Adding Further US/Canada Alignment on Biocides Evaluation Programs to Next RCC Joint Plan

ACA formally responded to the RCC-US RFI by supporting CPCA earlier submission asking for further alignment for biocides. The RCC next joint action plan is expected to in first quarter 2019.

CPCA Supports International Actions Against European Commission's Endorsement of TiO₂ Classification as Cat 2 Carcinogen

If allowed to proceed, this classification will have an impact on global trade and can cause significant trade disruptions in the North American paint and coatings trade industry. CPCA is supporting IPPIC's actions against this classification and works with Canada's Technical Barriers to Trade to quantify the direct economic impact on paint exports and on the national Architectural market as a whole.
